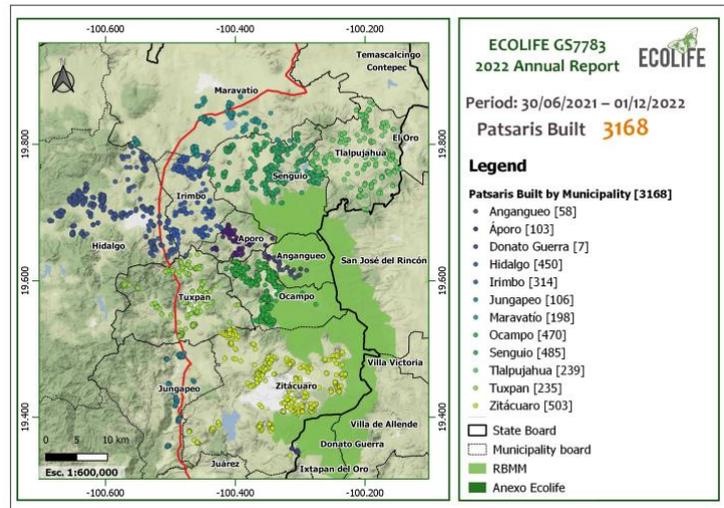

ECOLIFE Conservation’s Improved Cookstove Project, GS7783, has been actively implemented during the second monitoring period. The project has been successfully implemented following the approved project design, ensuring transparent monitoring of all SDG impacts and parameters. Verification is currently in progress for the second monitoring period, 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 – 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022.

The project start date is April 16<sup>th</sup> 2019 and received GS performance certification in December 2021. From project start date (16/04/2019) to 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022, a total of 6,486 Patsari stoves have been constructed as part of the project. During the first monitoring period (16/4/2019-30/6/2021), a total of 3,702 Patsari stoves were constructed, resulting in 20,300 tCO<sup>2</sup>e mitigated cumulatively.

As the second monitoring period has not concluded, it is not possible to define the total stoves built during the entire second monitoring period. However, covering most of the monitoring period, from 30/06/2021 – 01/12/2022, a total of 3,168 Patsari stoves were constructed. During the second monitoring period the project was implemented at an average rate of ~200 stoves/month, an increase from the first monitoring period. With the help of carbon funding, the project plans to increase implementation by over 50% in 2023.



The project’s monitoring system has been ongoing since project start and is carried out to ensure monitoring is representative of typical technology and fuel use practices among the project population. The project is continually refining the monitoring design and practices to optimize transparency and strengthen the overall monitoring system.

Following the requirements, a total sales records (project database) is continuously maintained, a monitoring and usage survey is conducted annually, and a field test is conducted every two years to update monitoring parameters over time.

A usage rate survey was completed during the second monitoring period from a random representative sample of project stoves in order to consider the variation of the monitored parameters. The survey was conducted following all of the requirement and guidelines set forth in the Gold Standard Usage Rate Monitoring and Rule Update. The project usage survey was carried out during October and November 2022 where a total of 152 surveys were collected across the four age groups. The full results of the project survey are under verification assessment, so the final results will be made available during verification and performance reviews. The samples as per age group is as follows:

- Age Group 0-1: 32
- Age Group 1-2: 33
- Age Group 2-3: 37
- Age Group 3-4: 50

A Project Kitchen Performance Test (KPT) was conducted during the first monitoring period in 2021. Although project performance field tests are required every two years, a Project KPT was completed during the second monitoring period in order to obtain consumption data for age group 3-4. There were no samples in age group 3-4 at the time of the 2021 KPT campaign. The Project KPT for age group 3-4 was performed with 35 samples collected on three consecutive days starting between 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2022. Field tests are conducted following the requirements set for in GS TPDDTEC v3.1 to measure real technology performance in the field with a representative sample of end users. The full and final results of the KPT analysis is available during verification assessment.

The project implements a variety of monitoring campaigns to better measure the real performance, enhance the operations, and improve the overall quality of the project. Project monitoring activities ensure that the project is being implemented as designed, project operations encourage proper adoption and sustained use of the technology, and that policies are being followed to ensure the highest measure of quality and safety. Among many recent monitoring activities undertaken by the project, the maintenance program was implemented during the second monitoring period. This includes analysis of technology lifespan, quality control surveys, maintenance surveys, replacement campaigns, and carbon waiver completion. These recent activities exemplify how the PD continually seeks to strengthen the project's monitoring system beyond the activities required by the methodology.
